## The New Trend In Renting Movies

With more than 13 million users, Netflix, Inc. is the world's largest subscription service streaming movies and TV episodes over the Internet and sending DVDs by mail. Netflix currently offers its members a choice of nine different plans beginning at \$4.99/month. You can have anywhere from one to eight DVDs out at-a-time, and all but one plan offers unlimited streaming of select movies and TV shows to your computer.

Mailing a movie back to Netflix and receiving the next movie on your queue is a very quick turnaround. From personal experience, if you mail a movie back on Monday, you will usually receive your next movie on Wednesday. Movies are mailed out in the order you have them listed in your Queue. If the top movie in your Queue is unavailable when your movie is received at the shipping center, the next movie is sent instead. Netflix has recently reached agreements with Warner Bros. Studios, Universal Studios and Twentieth Century Fox to delay renting new releases for 28 days from their retail release dates.

The option of unlimited streaming of movies and TV episodes right to your TV via gaming consoles and other devices was added in January 2008. Some of the devices that have this ability include Nintendo's Wii console, Sony's PS3 game consoles, Blue-ray disc players from Samsung, LG and Insignia, Internet TVs from LG, Sony and VIZIO TiVo digital video recorders and Apple's iPad.

Aside from a compatible device, wireless internet access is needed to utilize the straight-to-TV streaming. Haviland Telephone Company's DSL modems come with a built-in wireless router, so if you subscribe to one of our DSL services and own any of the devices mentioned, you have all you need to enjoy movies streamed straight to your TV.

Netflix also has a rating and suggestion feature to help you find DVD's you might be interested in. By rating movies or shows you have seen, Netflix suggests similar movies or shows you might like. Also, each time you add a movie to your Queue, suggestions for other movies or television shows are made based on the one you chose. This is a helpful tool in keeping your Queue filled with movies. The Queue also has an easy to use line-up. You can move the order of DVDs around and number them however you like, rather than being stuck receiving the movies in the order that you added them. If the weekend is coming up and you have a specific movie you'd like to watch, you can move it to the top of your Queue.

With Netflix there are no late fees, and you don't have to drive to the rental store, just to find the DVD you want is not available. Low monthly membership fees, unlimited DVD's each month and free shipping both ways makes Netflix a great alternative to the video store. Plus, it saves you on fees, gas and time.

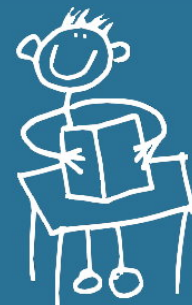
