Wireless Camera System

Do your kids walk home from school and forget to call when they make it home? Do you have a dog or cat that you need to keep an eye on throughout the day? Do you have an elderly parent or friend that you would like to be able to check on, but can't

The VueZone cameras were brought to our attention by a local business owner. So, what is it? A completely wire-free camera monitoring system that transmits wireless video to an online account so you can check it away from home. Video recorded by the VueZone camera is streamed wirelessly through your internet connection to online storage. With the free Basic plan you can log into your online storage from any web browser, and view footage that has been recorded. The Premier plan, available for \$4.95 per month or \$49.95 per year, allows you to have alerts sent directly to your smartphone or iPad, pan and zoom digitally, modify the motion sensor activation settings and much more.

For Your Information Copyright Infringement

Copyright owners take alleged infringements seriously. Since we are an Internet provider, we occasionally get notified by a copyright owner that one of our customers is transmitting an illegal copy of a movie. Please, note that our Acceptable Use Policy explicitly prohibits illegal activity. The copyright owner could subpoena your name and address, as well as proof that you were the customer sending or receiving protected material. If illegal copies of materials are suspected to reside on your computer, the copyright owner could obtain a search warrant to have the computer seized. Do you really want to risk this to save the price of a DVD? Keep in mind, if you are downloading a movie, TV show, music, book or games that you did not pay for, more than likely it is an illegal download.

Universal Service Funds

Our customers pay only a fraction of the cost to implement and maintain the network that makes local calling, 911, in-coming and out-going long distance calls, and high-speed Internet possible. The Federal Universal Service Fund and the Kansas Universal Service Fund draw money from other phone customers to help provide these services in areas where it isn't economical to provide these services based only on local customer revenues. Costs are higher in rural areas mostly because of 1) large distances from switching equipment to customers, and 2) very low population density. Generally, more urban areas in Kansas support our services, and more populated states support Kansas. Phone bills would run over \$100 per month higher without these programs.
