# CPNI Update

Over the last few months we've been reporting on possible changes that the FCC would be implementing regarding Customer Proprietary Network Information (CPNI). Those changes became effective Dec. 8th, 2007. CPNI is information created by the relationship between you and Haviland Telephone Company including your average call time, where you call, how often you call or even who your long distance carrier is. It does not include information such as your name, address, or telephone number. The FCC's purpose in CPNI is to protect your private information from unauthorized access. We would like all of our customers to feel comfortable knowing that Haviland Telephone Company has not and will not sell any CPNI to a third party.

Due to the FCC Changes, HTC will be required to verify your identification when you call or visit us regarding your telephone bill or unbilled toll. These forms of identification include:

- 1. Password Secret word or phrase of your choice.
- 2. Hint Questions Verification if you can't remember your password.
- 3. A copy of your bill Will mail copy of bill only to your address on record.
- 4. Photo ID When visiting our offices in person.
- 5. Callback Will hang up and call you back only at the number you are inquiring about.

# **Local Service Rate Changes**

In 2002 the Kansas Legislature passed a law establishing a method to set an affordable level for basic local service rates for rural telephone companies. The Kansas Corporation Commission has determined these rates to be a statewide average of \$15.00 for residential and \$18.00 for single line business service. Under this law, rural telephone companies adjust their local service rates over a transition period to achieve the KCC's target levels.

As a part of legislative and regulatory actions, Haviland Telephone will receive a reduced amount of high cost support from the Kansas Universal Service Fund to offset the local rate increase. Haviland Telephone will receive no additional revenue as a result of these rate changes.

We remind our customers of the Lifeline Service program, offering assistance for residential telephone service to qualifying limited income households.
