Winter Weather Preparedness

Below are pictures taken in Haviland after the Dec.10th ice storm. Due to these recent storms we are including some winter weather preparedness tips in this issue.





If you are at home:

Know your winter storm and extreme cold terms.

Have a corded phone on hand in case the power goes off. Cordless phones need electricity and WILL NOT WORK when the power goes out.

Assemble a **Disaster Supplies Kit** containing: First aid kit and essential medications, battery-powered NOAA weather radio, flashlight, extra batteries, canned food, can opener, bottled water (one gallon of water/person/day to last at least 3 days), warm clothing including boots, mittens, and a hat, extra blankets and a corded phone.

If you need to go outside:

Wear several layers of loose fitting, lightweight, warm clothing rather than one layer of heavy clothing. The outer garments should be tightly woven and water repellent. This will actually keep you warmer than a heavy coat.

Wear a hat and mittens, which are warmer than gloves.

Cover your mouth with a scarf to protect your lungs.

You should also assemble a Disaster Supplies Kit for your car. This Kit should include: a shovel, windshield scraper and small broom, flashlight, battery-powered radio, batteries, water, snack food, matches, extra socks, hats and mittens, First aid kit with pocket knife, necessary medications, blankets tow chain or rope, road salt and sand, booster cables, emergency flares and a fluorescent distress flag.
