

Over the last several years, social networking sites such as www.facebook.com, www.myspace.com and www.twitter.com exploded, connecting people and personal experiences across the world like never before. Now the entertainment industry is targeting customers through the Internet, with gaming, music, television and movies available to be streamed directly to your computer or television.

With so many choices for video streaming, wouldn't it be nice if there was one device you could hook up to your TV that would stream videos from Hulu, Netflix, and Amazon's Video on Demand? There is. The Roku Player is a small box that allows you to stream high definition movies and TV shows instantly to your TV. All you need to get going is a TV, a high-speed internet connection and a few minutes to set it up.

Once your Roku is connected, you simply select the channel you want to watch. Some channels, such as Roku Newscaster, Pandora, Crackle, Alloy TV, Facebook Photos and CHOW can be enjoyed for free on the device. Other channels, such as Netflix, Hulu, Video on Demand, MLB.TV, are considered Premium channels and do require subscriptions. If you already subscribe to any of these services, you can follow simple set up instructions and begin enjoying them on your TV through the Roku.

The Roku makes it easy to stream movies, video, music and more directly to your TV. There are 3 models to choose from, and all are reasonably priced. Haviland Telephone Company's modems come with built in wireless capability, or you can plug the Roku directly into the back of the modem for a wired connection.






