Haviland Telephone 2012 Scholarships Awarded To Exceptional Students

In addition, Montana Bailey of Sawyer, Kansas, was awarded \$1000 from the Foundation for Rural Education and Development (FRED) through her nomination by Haviland Telephone Company. FRED awarded \$76,000 in scholarships to some of the most outstanding students rural America has to offer. A total of 52 students were selected to receive scholarships from the organization. Close to 200 applicants applied to this program this year. Montana, a graduate Medicine Lodge High School, plans to attend Bethany College in the fall.

FRED is a national 501(c)(3) charitable foundation located in Washington, D.C., and was founded in 1989 by the Organization for the Promotion and Advancement of Small Telecommunications Companies (OPASTCO). The mission of FRED and its supporters is to promote educational, social and economic development in rural America and Canada. Only OPASTCO member companies are eligible to nominate a student.

Students who were interested in the scholarships applied to Haviland Telephone for a nomination earlier in the year.
