Movies Online

Have you been wondering what the next great thing about the computer age was going to be? Well, wonder no more! Now thanks to websites such as www.netflix.com, <a href="www.netflix.co

Most everyone has heard of Netflix, a company that mails movie rentals directly to your house, but did you know that you can also watch your movie selection instantly on your PC? Netflix has 5 different monthly plans and on all but one of them you get unlimited hours of movie watching on your PC in addition to the rentals through the mail. These packages include no late fees and free shipping both ways. System requirements for Netflix include Windows XP or higher and an active broadband connection to the Internet.

Movielink, owned by Blockbuster, is a rent or buy site. There are no subscription fees, and with your first download, you'll get the Movielink Manager, a program that helps you manage and view your movies. Rentals start at 99c/movie and you can store a movie for up to 30 days after checkout. Once you start playback, you can watch it as many times as you like for the 24 hour viewing period. Purchases start at \$1.99/ movie and there is no limit to how often you view these movies. System requirements for Movielink are Windows 2000 or higher and an active broadband connection to the internet.

Amazon Unbox is also a rent or buy site, with no monthly fees. You just need to install the Amazon Unbox video player, which allows you to watch and manage your movies and you're ready to go. Currently, the Unbox video player only works on PC's running Windows XP, and again an active broadband connection to the internet is required.

These are just three of the websites that are sweeping the internet age. Most computers already meet the requirements, you just need access to the internet. 2008 Lifeline/Linkup Poverty Level Guidelines

Lifeline is a service for low income households that helps pay some of the costs of a local phone bill. In order to qualify for lifeline, a customer must participate in one of the following:: food stamps, general assistance, supplemental security income (SSI), Temporary Assistance to Needy Families (TAR), Medicaid, United Tribes Food Distribution Program, BIA General Assistance, Tribally administered Temporary Assistance for Needy Families (TANF), Head Start (only those meeting its income qualifying standard), Free School Lunch Program OR have an Annual Household Income at or below 150% of the federal poverty level guidelines.
