**Samuel is bald.**

5. The 22nd and 24th presidents of the United States of America had the same parents but were not brothers. How can this be possible?

**They are the same man. Grover Cleveland served two terms as president of the United States but the terms were not consecutive.**

6. How many 1 foot by 1 foot bricks would it take to complete a building that's 20 feet long on all four sides and 20 feet high?

**Only one; the last brick you put in will complete it.**

7. The rungs of a 10 foot ladder attached to a ship are 1 foot apart. If the water is rising at the rate of one foot an hour, how long will it take until the water covers the entire ladder?

**It will never cover the ladder; as the water rises so will the floating ship.**

8. What gets wetter and wetter the more it dries?

**A towel.**
