FIGHTING FOR BETTER BROADBAND

re you one of our customers who would like broadband Internet service without the requirement of having a landline phone as well? You are not the only one. There is a high demand for stand-alone broadband Internet service all around the world. Rural telecommunications companies like us understand and acknowledge this, but we are unable to provide a true stand-alone broadband service at the same price we provide broadband with phone.

On our behalf, NTCA—The Rural Broadband Association and Western Telecommunications Alliance (WTA), are trying to make a change. NTCA and WTA have petitioned the FCC (Federal Communications Commission) to revise the rules that punish customers who would prefer to simply have stand-alone broadband.

Telecommunication companies such as ours receive
Universal Service support if a customer chooses to have
telephone service, a fee that is paid within the industry to
ensure we achieve maximum value from the nation's
interconnected networks. We pay into the fund and draw
from the fund based on the cost of serving our customers. As
of now, if a customer only wants broadband, the Universal
Service support is gone for that line, causing their broadband rates to skyrocket.
NTCA and WTA have implored the FCC to fix this and have had many
productive conversations with them, but there are still issues that need to be
resolved. As your total communications provider, we are continuing to solve
this problem with other companies through our national association. We
ensure that rural consumers have a voice at the table as Washington develops
regulations to guide us through this communication evolution.
