# Energy Savings Tips: From the "Smart" to the Simple

With energy costs continuing to rise, you might want to consider some low-tech gifts that give the gift of savings all year long by reducing energy consumption.

Vampire electronics are gadgets that consume standby power when they're not in use. In most homes, the computer workstation and home entertainment system are the biggest energy vampires but other culprits include small gadgets like phone chargers. The most obvious way to stop idle electronics from using electricity is to unplug them when they aren't in use, but this is not always practical. After all, who wants to spend 10 minutes every night unplugging stuff and 10 minutes plugging everything back in the next morning? More convenient alternatives include socket adapters with built-in timers (\$6-\$10) and "smart" or remote control power strips (\$30-\$40) that give you the plug/unplug functionality without physically going and doing it.

Heating and cooling a home is the largest energy expense for most homes, averaging 56 percent of an average households energy costs, according to the Department of Energy. They recommend turning your thermostat back 10° to 15° for 8 hours a day to cut your heating and cooling energy consumption by 5 to 15 percent a year. Programmable thermostats (\$40-\$150) let you change the temperature setting based on the time of day. For example, you can set them to modify temperature when you leave for work, and have the temperature return to a more comfortable setting before you return home. "Smart" thermostats (\$200-\$500) take it a step further by learning from your behaviors, allowing you to control the climate in your home remotely, and showing you energy consumption in real-time.

Ask about these cost-saving devices at your local hardware store or home improvement center.

### Never Miss A Call: Link Your Cellphone to a Home Phone System

Have you missed calls thanks to a misplaced cellphone, or a cellphone charging at the other end of the house? With Link-to-Cell phone systems, you can merge the best of both landline and cellphone technologies in your home or business. By leveraging Bluetooth® wireless-enabled technology, Link-to-Cell systems make it possible to place and receive cellular calls through a home phone system. Most Link-to-Cell systems come with a base station and 2-4 handsets for around \$100. One of our employees tested a system in her home and found the following features and benefits:

Make and receive landline and cellular calls. Once the devices are linked, any incoming cellular calls will ring through to one of the traditional handsets, regardless of where your cellphone is located. Most systems allow you to pair up to two cellphones with your landline, and backlit buttons on the handsets make it easy to identify which of the three lines is in use. The system even allows multiple lines to be used at once.

**Extend your coverage.** Link-to-Cell technology eliminates signal dead spots at home. Just place your cellphone where reception is best and enjoy strong coverage throughout your house. Since this technology works with or without a subscription to local phone service, it's perfect for cellular-only households, too.



**Download your contacts.** Do you find yourself making important calls on less-than-reliable cellphones because that is where the number is stored? With these phone systems you don't have to. Pair hundreds of names and numbers from your cellular phone and have all your contacts on available on the handsets.

Other features. Many models provide a port for charging your cellphone at the base station, and will even alert you through the handsets when a text message has been received on one of your cellphones.

# Amazing TV Entertainment Available Through Internet



This is an exciting time in the world of entertainment. You have so many more options on how to access TV programs, movies, and music to enjoy at home. No longer are you restricted to the choice of either a cable TV subscription or a satellite dish as you have been in years passed. With a video streaming device and Haviland Telephone Internet service, you have the opportunity to enjoy a vast array of streaming entertainment on your TV.

Streaming devices allow you access to hundreds of streaming video channels, or applications, including Netflix, Hulu Plus, YouTube, Disney, Amazon Prime Instant Video, Pandora, and many of your favorite cable networks. The content provided for the network channels is not identical to what you would receive with a satellite or cable subscription, but they still provide access to up-to-theminute news, quality family programming and sporting events coverage. The majority of these channels come pre-loaded or are free to download, but some need to be paid for either upfront or through a monthly subscription (like Netflix). We will review some of the most popular options for video streaming devices here.

#### Roku or Apple TV streaming box.

Both devices cost \$100 or less and are by far the most popular options for streaming boxes. If you already own Apple devices and enjoy watching content on YouTube, Apple TV is likely the device for you. With




its AirPlay feature, you can play content from your other Apple devices directly to your TV wirelessly. Apple TV also has a direct YouTube channel, which Roku does not. If you would like to be able to discover new content easily and watch content from Amazon Prime Instant video, then Roku is your best bet. Its search feature does a great job of letting you search through the myriad of viewing options without having to open each channel. And currently, AppleTV does not provide access to Amazon Prime Instant video.

# Chromecast Streaming Stick. At just \$35, this device is simply a dongle you plug into your TV's HDMI port.
